In translation, stylistic errors should not be confused with linguistic errors, which will incorporate mistakes in spelling, punctuation and grammar.. Linguistic errors deviate from accepted rules of language as opposed to the stylistic rules of the company. Stylistic rules are set out in a translation style guide.

The subject and verb of a sentence must agree with one another in number, whether they are singular or plural. If the subject of the sentence is singular, its verb must also be singular; and if the subject is plural, the verb must also be plural.

One of the most common grammatical errors is mixing up "well" and "good." In general, "well" is an adverb, while "good" is an adjective. When you aren't sure which one to use, simply ask yourself whether an adjective or an adverb is appropriate for the situation.
