Leopard geckos are insectivores, which means that they eat bugs. No vegetables, fruit, or meat – they're just crazy for bugs! It's easy to remember how much to feed your gecko: Offer 2 appropriately-sized bugs per 1 inch of your leopard gecko's length, or however much they can eat in 15 minutes. Juveniles should be fed daily, and young adults fed every other day/every 3 days.

Best Leopard Gecko Lighting Setups. Here is a quick overview of a 5-element setup for any leo tank: Incandescent heat lamp as daylight.; T5 or T8 5-6% UVB bulb (2-3% for albinos).; Ceramic bulb for nighttime heating, or a heating pad if your tank is too small.; Red, blue, or black night light, which should be for a couple of hours while you want to watch your geckos (optional).
