Operation Gladio Operation Gladio is a NATO -backed paramilitary network established after WW2, originally inspired by fear of the USSR. It was also called the " Stay behind network ", since if the Red Army invaded Europe, its members would "stay behind" enemy lines to disrupt Soviet control.
